NAACP Environmental Justice Program: Program was created to support community leadership in addressing the disproportionate impact that environmental injustice and proliferation of climate change has on communities of color and low income communities. Does so by addressing the practices that are harmful to communities and the policies needed to rectify these impacts and advance a society that fosters sustainable, cooperative, regenerative communities that uphold all rights for all people in harmony with the earth.

<u>350Vermont</u>: Mission is to unite a mass movement for bold solutions that both lift up Vermonters and cut down carbon—to be a national and global example for solving the climate criss. Through rallies, advocacy, trainings, workshops, and social media 350VT calls on people around the world to come together to fight for climate justice. Current campaigns: Tar Sands Free Vermont; Divest VT; Climate Cabaret; Transportation for Livable Communities; and Green Mountain Brigade.
